

Photo specifications for Permanent Residence

Notes to the applicant

TAKE THIS WITH YOU TO THE PHOTOGRAPHER

- Immigration photographs are *not* the same as passport photographs.
- Make sure that you provide the correct number of photographs specified in the *Checklist*.

Notes to the photographer

The photographs must:

- show a full front view of the person's head and shoulders showing full face centred in the middle of the photograph;
- have a **plain white background**;
- be identical (black and white or colour) produced from the same untouched negative, or exposed simultaneously by a split-image or multi-lens camera;

The photographs must:

- measure between 25 mm and 30 mm from chin to crown
- have a 35 mm x 45 mm finished size
